



COMPULSORY ENROLMENT DOCUMENTATION

As Grandis Primary School is a local intake only school, you must be residing in our catchment area to make an application. Please see below a list of documents that are required to be produced before completing an enrolment form. See map on reverse for details:

From the junction of Pinjar Road and Grandis Boulevard, north along Pinjar Road (east side included) and north along the proposed extension of Pinjar Road to Flynn Drive, east along Flynn Drive (south side included) to Old Yanchep Road, south along Old Yanchep Road (west side included) to Joondalup Drive, west and south west along Joondalup Drive (north and north west sides included) to Parakeelya Road, west along Parakeelya Road (north side included) to Ghost Gum Boulevard, north along Ghost Gum Boulevard (east side included) to Kurrajong Boulevard, west along Kurrajong Boulevard (north side included) to Joseph Banks Boulevard and continuing west through the school site to Pinjar Road, and north along Pinjar Road (east side included) to Grandis Boulevard.

Compulsory documents required for proof of residence:

➤ Owner Occupied Properties

- Current council rate notice
AND
- Latest utility (ie. electricity) account addressed to the applicant at the address on the enrolment form

**Please note that mail addressed to PO Boxes will not be accepted*

➤ Rental Properties

Rental Agreements through a registered Real Estate Agent

- **Current Rent/Lease agreement with an expiry date no less than December 31 of the enrolment year.**
AND
- Latest electricity account addressed to the applicant at the address on the enrolment form

**Please note that mail addressed to PO Boxes will not be accepted*

Private Rental Agreements

- Latest utility account. (ie. electricity) addressed to the Enrolment Applicant at the applicant's enrolment address **AND**
- Current Rent/Lease agreement of at least 6 months

** Plus the owner of the property must provide:*

- Proof of ownership by providing the current council rate notice for the applicant's enrolment address in their name
- In the case of family lease arrangements – a written Statutory Declaration Form (available from any Post Office) completed and signed by the owner, outlining the lease arrangements. Witnessed accordingly. This must be current and for at least 6months.

Compulsory documents required to determine enrolment eligibility:

- Original Birth Certificate (not extract)
- Passport and Visa documentation if applicable
- Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR) Statement. This can be obtained through ACIR on 1800 653 809, emailing acir@humanservices.gov.au or visiting a Medicare office in person.
