



PRINCIPAL'S REPORT TO P&C

1. Fundraising Plan

Attached is a draft plan with school fundraising activities included.

2. School Board

The School Board meeting which was scheduled for tonight was postponed until 25 June as this was a better date for a number of members. Cindy Davis has accepted an invitation from the School Board to be a co-opted community member in 2019/20.

3. Stage 2 Construction Progress

Construction is going according to schedule. We anticipate that practical completion will occur before the end of the year.

4. Carpark Safety

There have been a few instances of parents speeding through the school carpark. We will be sending out messages via SchoolStream to remind parents of the need to drive safely in and around the school. We have asked the Go Bananas bus to park closer to the entrance to make moving students to the bus easier and safer.

5. Playground Usage and Safety

The school has allowed parents and children to remain on school grounds for a short period after closing to facilitate networking and positive play. However, we have noticed that a number of parents are not providing the necessary level of supervision and control to ensure safety to children and equipment. We will advertise the rules (below) on SchoolStream and monitor compliance.

- At Grandis PS we are kind, respectful, responsible, learners
- Walk, don't run on the equipment
- Climb on, don't jump off the equipment
- One person, feet first on the slide
- No more than 5 on the bridge or platforms at a time
- No climbing, sitting, standing on top rails or any part of the raised playground equipment
- Sandpit is out of bounds after school – do not walk on or under the covers
- Keep off fences and garden beds
- No access to school buildings after being dismissed from the classroom

6. Promoting 2020 Enrolments

We need to know what our likely enrolment numbers will be as soon as possible. We ask that parents remind new families arriving to the area that they can enroll for 2020 now. This can be done at the school office.
