### 1. Thankyou!!

- Special thanks go to the P&C and parent helpers who provided refreshments and lunches at last week's Faction Athletics Carnival. This was greatly appreciated by staff, students and the general community. If you have feedback about the Faction Carnival please email me and let me know.

### 2. COVID Update

- An additional allocation of RAT tests were made available to parents this term. We only managed to distribute around half of them and there is also half of the previous allocation available. We will continue to encourage parents to collect their allocation.

### 3. Cross Walk

- It is hoped that the crosswalk will be installed in the next school holiday

### 4. Painting

- Eating areas will be painted on the next school holidays (starts 27 Sept). This will seal the concrete making it easier to clean. It will also be more hygienic. Areas are in front of Jarrah, Wattle, Karri and Tuart Blocks.
- Lines will also be painted on areas of concrete outside Banksia Block. This will provide more games and activities for students in the ECE play area.
