



PRINCIPAL'S REPORT TO P&C

14 February 2023

1. Restructure

A restructure of some of the classes occurred last week. This was required due to a large number of new enrolments and the need to provide space for future enrolments in some year levels. There is a strong chance that another restructure will be required later in the year.

2. Nature Play

This was completed over the school holidays. We are still waiting for the installer to replace some of the larger sections of damaged grass.

3. Grass Repairs

Grass across the school is looking a lot better. Top dressing will be the next part of the repair process. This will likely happen over the next school holidays.

4. Cross Walk

The cross walk has been partially completed. Signage still needs to be installed. WA Police are in the process of selecting a suitable person to employ as the crossing warden. Interested parents/community members can obtain an application form by phoning the Children's Crossing Unit on 62748734.

5. Transportables

These buildings are now fully functional as classrooms.

6. Assemblies

With the lifting of COVID restrictions we will be conducting assemblies again this year. Year level assemblies will be held rather than specific classroom assemblies. Teachers will let parents know when their child's class is involved in an assembly so that they can attend.

7. Illegal Parking

The City of Wanneroo has been asked to send out their Ranger to monitor parking around the school during pick up time. They will issue warnings/fines as needed.

8. Your Move Program

The school has signed up to the 'Your Move' program. 'Your Move' is a free program helping students get active by increasing walking, scooting and riding to school. Travel behaviour change experts will work with 'Your Move' Champions to tackle traffic issues and help provide practical ways to teach & develop sustainability at our school.
