



PRINCIPAL'S REPORT TO P&C

1. Census

We currently have 660 students enrolled at the school. It is predicted that the school will continue to grow by about 80 – 100 students for the next couple of years.

2. School Photos

School photos were taken on Monday and Friday of Week 5. In future years the photographers will look at opening the sibling photo times earlier to allow for more bookings.

3. Lockdown Drill

The drill took place last Wednesday. All students and staff were secured inside rooms within two minutes. The school will also conduct Bushfire Drills as well as a general Evacuation Drill before the end of Term 2.

4. NAPLAN

Year 3 and 5 students will commence the annual NAPLAN testing this week. These tests are being held earlier so that results can be used in a timelier way by teachers. In previous years we did not receive results until the end of Term 3.

5. Cross Walk

6. Your Move Program

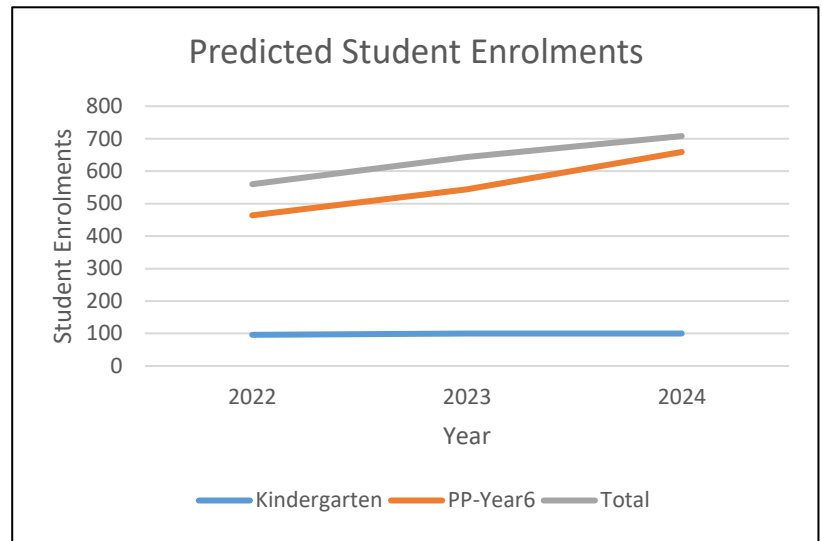
